The purpose of the Virginia B. Toulmin Scholarship is to prepare the next generation of Education and Related Service professionals by providing support to students who have worked for The Town of Hempstead

Camp ANCHOR Summer program.

Scholarships are competitive and are one-time awards.

What

This year there will be (5) \$5,000.00 awards for tuition and other academic expenses. Funds must be used in the 2023/2024 academic year.

If study is not continuous, the award must be forfeited. It cannot be held for future use. In these cases, candidates may re-apply when re-enrolled in a program of study.

Who

This scholarship is available to full or part-time students who are pursuing a course of study in an Education or therapy related field, including those studying to become an Educator, OT, PT, Speech Therapist, Psychologist, Health care or Social Worker.

Eligible Applicants:

- Must be enrolled or accepted for enrollment in an Associate, Baccalaureate, or Graduate degree program in an Education or Therapy Related program at an accredited school.

BENEFITS

If study is not continuous, the award must be forfeited. It cannot be held for future use. In these cases, candidates may re-apply when re-enrolled in a program of study.

Eligible Applicants

- 1. Must have been employed by Camp Anchor for the full summer prior to the application deadline.
- 2. Must be enrolled or accepted for enrollment in a baccalaureate, graduate or associate degree program in an accredited school
